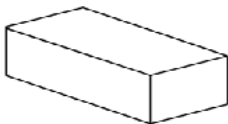

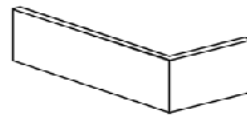
Thin Brick - Flats

- Bricks Inc. may stock reclaimed full depth and thin brick on any given day, but these products are sold on a first come, first serve basis. Materials will not be held without signed order & deposit.
- Bricks In. can offer contacts who will test reclaimed materials for compression, IRA, and other measures, but those cost to do such tests would be on the buyer.
- In addition to full brick, we offer thin cut products for applications where a full brick may not be necessary. Thin Brick has in recent years become a popular wall covering for restaurant interiors, commercial projects, and residences.
- When ordering reclaimed materials, please specify the color/batch to you sales rep so they can offer an estimate based on your specific needs.
